This workshop will reflect on the work to date of the Carer Rights and Complaints Network (CRCN), a working group led by Carers NSW and DCJ that

has produced a series of eight 'Know your rights' [fact sheets](#) and [webinars](#) for carers focused on a range of settings.

Feedback will then be sought from attendees on the future of the Carer Rights Education project under the [NSW Carers Strategy: Caring in 2020 – 2030](#), exploring emerging challenges in relation to carer rights and complaints, and opportunities to further expand awareness and uptake of complaints mechanisms among carers in NSW.
