Recovery and Wellbeing Educator (Peer) Duties

As a Recovery & Wellbeing Educator (Peer) you will be required to undertake the following:

- Work in partnership with a mental health clinician and Recovery & Wellbeing College staff to co-write and/or co-facilitate courses
- Attendance at regular meetings and additional consultations as required
- Provide regular progress updates to the Education Coordinator
- Attendance at the Recovery & Wellbeing College Educator Training Program courses (RPL available) *Please note attendance at this training is strongly encouraged, however it is not compulsory. Payment is not provided for attendance at these training sessions.

Criteria for Recovery & Wellbeing Educators (Peer)

- 1. Personal experience of mental health concerns/distress/suicidal crisis, and/or as a carer; and the ability to use lived experience in education as a learning process for others
- 2. Experience in writing and/or facilitating education
- 3. Solid understanding of and commitment to mental health recovery and social and emotional wellbeing philosophy
- 4. Ability and willingness to work in collaboration with other team members, including Clinical Educators
- 5. Strong verbal and written communication skills
- 6. Ability to manage own time effectively and work to a deadline
