## THE NATIONAL REDRESS SCHEME

What you need to know

A half day workshop for Aboriginal community organisations and services **The National Redress Scheme for** survivors of institutional child sexual abuse started on 1 July 2018 and will close on 30 June 2028. The Federal **Government has funded specialist** services across Australia to provide support to survivors as they engage with the redress process.

**Five of the NSW Redress Support** Services (KBHAC, Link-up NSW, PWDA, Wattle Place and SAMSN ) have formed a steering committee to engage with **Aborignal community organisations** and services ensuring you have detailed information about the National Redress Scheme at your finger tips.

- Information about the Northern Territory Stolen Generations Redress Scheme.

- Q & A session answering your questions about the National Redress Scheme.
