## What you need to know

A half day workshop for Aboriginal community organisations and services

**The National Redress Scheme for survivors of institutional child sexual abuse started on 1 July 2018 and will close on 30 June 2028. The Federal Government has funded specialist services across Australia to provide support to survivors as they engage with the redress process.**

**Five of the NSW Redress Support Services (KBHAC, Link-up NSW, PWDA, Wattle Place and SAMSN) have formed a steering committee to engage with Aboriginal community organisations and services ensuring you have detailed information about the National Redress Scheme at your finger tips.**

### **The half day workshop will cover:**

- Detailed information about the National Redress Scheme, including from the Commonwealth Department of Social Services responsible for the scheme;
- Information about the Northern Territory Stolen Generations Redress Scheme.
- Presentations from the Aboriginal specialist and other Redress Support Services.
- Q & A session answering your questions about the National Redress Scheme.
